
I am really excited for the month of September and how our UP Church community will be gearing up to Love God and Love Others! On September 12th we will kick off the fall with a new year of Sunday School classes, beginning at 8:45 am. During worship, which begins at 10 am, I will begin a new sermon series called 'Symbols of Our Faith', where we will learn more about what it means to be a Presbyterian. If you have friends who might be interested in learning more about our church, this is a great time to invite them to attend. These are wonderful opportunities to learn more about God (which is a way of showing our Love for God) and to be in community with others (a way to show our Love for the people around us).

A lot of other background things are happening as well! The Session has decided to sell the two farms associated with the Pringle Estate. The sale will happen sometime in September. In order to help discover where God is leading, the session has asked a team of people to help us as a congregation begin to dream and imagine what good stewardship of the funds we will receive could look like. The Session also received a report from Personnel that Jake and Erin Thorius are resigning from their paid leadership positions. Thankfully both of them plan to remain active as volunteers, and the Session is exploring what our next step will be in regard to paid leadership for our youth and children.

The last thing I'm excited about is an idea we're going to try out with our church family over the next 9 months, beginning in October. Households will be grouped into nine teams, one for each month, and a team leader will be assigned. Each team (around 15-20 people) will be responsible for one month of tasks at the church - greeting and handing out announcement sheets, making sure the nursery is staffed during worship, putting out coffee and water each Sunday, occasionally helping with a children's sermon or scripture reading (assistance provided by Pastor Erin), organizing one potluck or snack after worship per month, and possibly sending cards or calling homebound church members. My hope is that people will feel that they are involved with service to the church while not being overtasked, and to allow everyone in our church family a chance to serve each other in some way.

Please continue to hold your church family and our wider world in your prayers as we walk together, trusting that God loves us and plans for our future.

#### **Adult Sunday School Class Opportunity**

Where do we get everything we need in life? From the Lord our God. How does he strengthen us? With his word. Join us for a new study of his word.

On Sunday September 19th the Adult Sunday School class in the lounge is starting the year with a new study, The Rock, the Road and The Rabbi by Kathie Lee Gifford and Rabbi Jason Sobel. Begin your journey to a deeper faith and understanding of the bible through their book and the companion six session video Bible study. Join them in visiting sites in Israel that have impacted Kathy Lee's life. As she shares her story, coauthor Rabbi Jason Sobel, a messianic Jewish rabbi, provides fascinating background details that make the story of the New Testament come alive. Kathie Lee and Rabbi Sobel will take you and your group beyond the typical "Sunday School" teaching to examine the true texts of the Bible. The six video sessions include:

1: Bethlehem: Where it all Began2: Nazareth: the early years.Capernaum: Ministry Headquarters

3: Capernaum: Ministry Headquarters 4: Galilee: Ministry Grounds

5: Mount of Olives: The Triumphal Entry 6: Jerusalem: Crucifixion and Resurrection.

We will be using the accompanying book to this series which also contains another 23 chapters focusing on understanding the importance of other locations in the Bible. This is a great opportunity to understand the meaning of our holy scriptures and to "tour" the Holy Land. Come join us September 12 for the introduction to this study and to reserve your copy of the book.
