
Shepherd's Staff


Youth Mission Trip Fundraiser

Diapers and Wipes Drive

During the month of April, we will be collecting diapers and wipes for The Family Connection program. This program is a home visitor program for all families with children age prenatal-kindergarten in both Washington and Henry Counties. They provide two home visits per month and use the Parents as Teachers curriculum to teach families about child development and the importance of play in early childhood. The program is voluntary and absolutely free. They also have incentives for the families and are seeking donations for the incentive program.



They frequently give out packages of diapers (various sizes) and wipes. Huggies or Pampers brands are preferred due to skin sensitivities and allergies. You may leave your donation at the church in the pack and play, which will be set up in the fellowship area.
