The prophet Isaiah wrote, 'For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder.

And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of

Isaiah was probably talking about a new baby in his own time, but his words have been used to reference the birth of Jesus, the Messiah. As we enter the season of Advent, the time in the church year when we prepare for the birth of Jesus, I invite you to consider with me what Isaiah's words mean when we apply them to Jesus. Each week of Advent, beginning November 27, we will explore one of Isaiah's names for Jesus.

While I have been preparing my sermons, the song, 'O Lord how shall I meet you' has been playing in my mind. The first verse is especially meaningful to me as I prepare for the birth of Jesus.

O Lord, how shall I meet you, how welcome you aright? Your people long to greet you, my hope, my heart's delight!

Oh, kindle, Lord most holy, your lamp within my breast to do in spirit lowly all that may please you best.

How do we prepare ourselves to welcome Jesus? We hope for him, we look for him, and we seek to serve him humbly. As we learn about the names that Jesus is called, let us continue to look for his arrival with hope and humility.


