From the Pastor...

Friends,

This month I will celebrate 20 years as an ordained pastor. As I reflect over the past 20 years, I cannot help but be amazed at the growth and experiences God has provided. I continue to be both humbled and full of gratitude for the places God has both brought me and brought me through. While the journey of life has not always been easy, God has always been faithful.

One place I continue to see evidence of God's faithfulness is in my call to this church. You had been looking for nearly two years when we connected, and had faced some disappointment in your search. However, you also were given great leadership in the person of Bill Warhover, who helped you look at who you were and who God was calling you to be. You were ready for your new pastor. I was looking for a new challenge, and a good place for our family. UP Church and the city of Washington seemed a great fit. Together we walked through a year of getting to know each other and sharing ministry before Covid entered the picture. Thanks to the work of previous years in upgrading our technical capabilities, equipment, and volunteer base, our worship continued without much struggle as we moved to livestream for several months. I heard so many stories of colleagues who were not in the same boat their churches had no capability to livestream services, no equipment, no volunteers - it was a huge learning curve for them. I was so thankful for God's provision and for the work the people of this church did in making the difficult changes required to upgrade and improve our abilities to share worship online. As Covid lessened, we moved back to meeting in person, and we began to see an influx of families with young children. Again, thanks to the provision of God and the work and dedication of those who went before, as well as those here now, we are hiring a Family Ministry Director to help nurture our youth and children, and young people are a welcome and included part of our church family. And again, I have many colleagues who are in a different boat - in congregations where there are few or no children, where budgets are shrinking, where the halls are quiet and empty.


