

# From the Pastor...

Friends,

This month we are entering a period of learning more about stewardship. Beginning on October 8, I will be preaching a 4 week sermon series called 'You have heard it said...' This is a play on one of Jesus' favorite things to say to people. Many times Jesus uses the phrase "You have heard it said." It is helpful to know that Jesus was using a rabbinic idiom in that phrase – the word "say," amar, was used by the rabbis to mean "interpret" in terms of giving the proper interpretation of the scriptures as to how to apply its laws. Jesus often preceded his legal rulings with "You have heard it said" (meaning, others have interpreted God's word to mean one thing) and "but I say unto you" (meaning, I interpret it differently, in the following way).

During those weeks, we will explore some things that we've heard said about money, the love of God, and being a follower of Jesus, while looking at how Jesus might interpret those sayings differently. As Christians, we are often reminded that Jesus has a different perspective on the world. He taught that how we handle our money is a reflection of our heart. Money, for the follower of Jesus, is a tool for the kingdom. As we walk through the next four weeks, we will explore how we are using the tool of our finances for the kingdom of God. At the end of the month, we will ask you to consider a pledge to the mission and ministry of the United Presbyterian Church. During the next few weeks we will also hear stories from church family members about the mission and ministry of the church and how these have impacted their lives.

I hope that you will journey with us over the next four weeks. I am looking forward to exploring what we have heard said, and what Jesus might tell us differently!


